



## Laborers' Local 265 Scholarship

### About the scholarship:

The Laborers' Local 265 Scholarship Fund is for dependent children of members of Laborers local 265.



**Amount:** up to \$1,000

**Timeline:** start accepting applications January 1, 2024

**Deadline:** May 1, 2024 for new applications, June 3, 2024 for renewals

### Eligibility:

- Must be a child (whether natural, adopted, stepchild, or grandchild) of an active member in good standing (excluding full-time officers and staff at the union hall)
- Enrolled or plan to be enrolled full-time in a post-secondary ( after attaining a high school diploma or GED) course of study for vocational or technical training certification, or a degree at an eligible educational institution.
- Minimum 2.5 cumulative high school grade-point average (or equivalent); renewal consideration requires a 3.0 cumulative GPA.
- U.S citizen or legal resident with verification-stamped 1-552 unexpired
- 25 years old or younger
- Must be registered to vote if eligible

### Application Process:

If eligible, you must submit an application form to 3457 Montgomery Rd., Cincinnati, Ohio 45207, or via email at

After applying, a committee appointed by trustees will base selection on the completed application, academic performance, community service, motivation, character, and self-help.

## Laborers' Local 265 Scholarship

### Basic Requirement and Supporting Document:

- Currently enrolled in (or accepted into) an accredited college, university, or vocational-technical school or training institution.
- Certified copy of a birth certificate
- Proof of voter registration (if eligible)
- Admission confirmation from your college/university/vocational school
- Detailed tuition statement to include all other scholarships awarded, also include a current FASFA Student Aid Report
- Email or send along with your application a grade report for each term (minimum 2.5 cumulative high school grade-point average (or equivalent); renewal consideration requires a 3.0 cumulative GPA). Must be an official school transcript
- Essay/Personal statement (300 words or more) addressing the following: "My goal in life is..."
- Two (2) letters of recommendation
- A thank you note to the donors and selection committee members for this fund is not required but always appreciated and may be mailed c/o Laborers' Local 625 Scholarship Fund, 3457 Montgomery Rd., Cincinnati, Ohio 45207, or via email at [local265scholarshipfund@gmail.com](mailto:local265scholarshipfund@gmail.com)

### Award Process:

The annual award amount will be based on the earnings of the funds. Formal notification of award will be made by the Scholarship Fund to the selected recipient(s). Awards will be paid to the school for the benefit of the student and must be applied to tuition, fees, books, supplies, and/or equipment required for coursework.

### Renewable Award:

This award will be renewed for a maximum of 4 total years of support provided the student meets the scholarship requirements and funding remains available.
